SAFETY ORIENTATION

WELCOME AND WHY ARE YOU HERE

- Welcome and thank them for their time
- Safety is at the forefront with the club and we want to do all we can to assure a safe riding experience for all

COLLECTION OF EMERGENCY FORM

- Explain why we are collecting this information and that the club will supply them a wallet sized copy that must be carried with them on all rides

REVIEW OF CLOSED CLUB RIDE QUALIFICATIONS

- Use the “Club Closed Ride Outline” document for this portion

REVIEW OF THE RIDE

- Use the “Club Closed Ride Outline” document for this portion

REVIEW CLUB HAND SIGNALS

- Review each hand signal and discuss when and why they would be used
- All riders are expected to pass all hand signals forward or back as required
- Why we do not want the passengers using the hand signals

T-CLOCKS VIDEO

- Show the video
- After the video ask for questions and allow open discussion

GROUP RIDE VIDEO

- Show the video
- After the video ask for questions and allow open discussion

THE ONE-TWO SECOND RULE

- Explain why we follow this process
- Does everyone understand how to measure the one-two seconds
- When riding single file you will be two seconds behind the bike in front of you

GROUP RIDING THROUGH TURNS

- Explain the bread crumbs rule, you are responsible for the bike behind you
- Show the video, it would be a good idea to stop and start the video so that you can discuss what they are doing and why they are doing it
- After the video ask for questions and allow open discussion

LANE KEEPING IN TURNS

- Explain why you should keep to your tire track if possible and continue following the one-two second through twists in the road
- Show the video, it would be a good idea to stop and start the video so that you can discuss what they are doing and why they are doing it
- After the video ask for questions and allow open discussion

EXPECTATIONS OF PROBATIONARY PERIOD

- Use the Safety Orientation form for this
- Explain that riders must have this form with them until they have completed the four ride probation period
- Remind them that the forms are available on the web site

SUMMARY AND QUESTION PERIOD

- This is a time for review and an opportunity for anyone with a question to speak up
- Make sure that everyone leaves with a full understanding of why we are doing this and what their responsibilities are

SIGN OFF OF SAFETY ORIENTATION FORM

- Sign everyone's forms and collect the forms for any passengers
- You will be responsible to let the Head RC know who attended the orientation and hand in all Emergency Contact forms and passenger Safety Orientation forms to the Head RC in a timely matter
